### **PROPOSED ADMISSION POLICY (FALL-2020)**

#### **GENERAL ADMISSION POLICY FOR ALL GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS:**

- a) University of Narowal (UON) admissions shall be accomplished against the advertisement given in print and electronic media for every new Semester(s).
- b) The University shall establish facilitation centers for the guidance of the applicants for admissions in the University during the office hours.
- c) All offered degree program(s) shall run under semester system.
- d) In specific circumstances University reserves the right not to offer any particular degree program(s).
- e) Subject to the minimum required number of students and departmental resources following number of seats shall be offered;
  1. Maximum number of seats offered in each program is 15 / Program.
- f) Applicant shall submit separate admission form for each program.
- g) In case of “O”, “A” level education or foreign certificate a Marks Equivalence Certificate (MEC) from Inter Board Committee of Chairman (IBCC) shall be required. In case of any other relevant equivalent degree the Equivalence Certificate from HEC shall be required.
- h) Incomplete applications shall not be considered for admission.
- i) It is necessary to submit all the mandatory documents attested by gazetted officer (2 recent passport size photographs, copy of CNIC (Applicant & Guardian), all academic (Matric, Intermediate, Bachelor and Masters) certificates etc. along with the filled admission form.
- j) While filling the application, use your name as it appears on your matriculation or O-level certificate HEC does not accept any change in name, when degrees are submitted for attestation.
- k) There shall be no age limit for applying in graduate programs.
- l) Applicants shall have to pay @ Rs 1500/= (Fifteen Hundred Rupees) per admission at the distribution point; Whereas, all admission Fee/dues shall have to be paid within notified stipulated time; otherwise, the admission shall stand cancel.
- m) Applicants shall submit affidavit at the time of the enrollment that they shall abide by the rules and regulations of the university and throughout the degree program students shall not take part in any activity which is against the code of conduct of the university. Otherwise university has all the right to cancel the admission and withhold degree.
- n) University of Narowal shall follow the instructions and guidelines of HEC regarding the admissions in all degree programs.

- o) Submission of any unreadable, forged or tampered document, is strictly prohibited. Such candidates shall be blacklisted for admission in any of our programs. In such case, university reserves the right to inform the Higher Education Commission, Pakistan.
- p) List of selected Applicants shall be displayed on UON website ([www.uon.edu.pk](http://www.uon.edu.pk)) and notice boards as per admission calendar.

### **1. M.Phil ADMISSION CRITERIA:**

- 1.1 Sixteen years of schooling or 4-years education after F.A. /F.Sc. (minimum 130 credit hours) in the respective subject from HEC recognized institutions is a prerequisite for admission to M.Phil program. Foreign degrees equivalent to BS (hons)/ BA (Hons)/BA/M.A/MSc/MBA or equivalent is also accepted for admission in M.Phil.
- 1.2 Minimum CGPA of 2.50 on a scale of 4.00 in BS/BA (Hons)/MA/MSc/Masters/MBA or equivalent on semester system or 50% marks in terminal degree in Annual System is required for admission to M.Phil.
- 1.3 Selection shall be made based on cumulative merit determined from previous academic degree(s)/certificate(s) CGPA/average (semester system/annual system), and marks obtained in the written entry test with following weights. i.e Academic Qualifications: 70% ii. Entry test: 30%.

### **2. Entry Test Format:**

- 2.1 University will conduct an entry test of 100 marks, which will include following section:

Subject	60 %
Analytical	20%
English	10%
Math	10%
<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

- 2.2 Test Passing marks are 50.
