NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the recommendations of the Convener Admission Committee, and in accordance with Section 15(1) of Act X of 2018 of the University of Narowal, the Vice Chancellor is pleased to approve the following Admission Policy for Undergraduate Programs for the Fall-2025 intake, subject to the anticipatory approval of the Academic Council:

UNIVERSITY OF NAROWAL ADMISSION POLICY FOR THE UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS SEMESTER FALL - 2025 (UNDER SEMESTER SYSTEM RULES)

1. GENERAL CRITERIA

1.1 University of Narowal will commence the online admissions for all Undergraduate Degree Programs (Morning and Self-Support) given in the **Annexure-I.** Online admissions shall be processed against the advertisement in print and electronic media under Semester System on Open Merit and Reserved Quotas as given in **Annexure-II**.

1.2 The eligible applicants (Male / Female / Transgender) can apply without any discrimination for admissions at University of Narowal.

1.3 Unless, mentioned in **Annexure-II**, the reserved seats are only for the Morning Degree Programs.

1.4 Only complete application(s) along with following compulsory documents shall be processed:

- a. Candidate's passport size photograph (with blue background).
- b. Matriculation and Intermediate or Equivalent Certificate/DMC issued by respective Board at the time of application.
- c. In case of any discrepancy, fake documentation or concealment of facts, the admission shall be cancelled at any stage of the degree.
- d. The applicants applying for reserved seats must attach all relevant documents mentioned in the attached **Annexure-II**; otherwise, the application shall not be processed.
- e. Applicants shall deposit amount of Rs. 1000/- (Non-Refundable) against each program applied for admission. Challan form for admission processing fee will be generated at online admission portal, and student shall upload the copy of paid challan at online admission portal of University of Narowal.
- **1.5** Considering eligibility, a candidate may apply for more than one-degree programs.

1.6 Result awaiting candidates can also apply. Their merit will be calculated on basis of Part-I of Intermediate or equivalent. Candidates with any failed subject (s) in Part-1 are not

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eligible for admission. Upon successful completion of Part-2 of intermediate or equivalent, applicant have to submit attested copy of complete result card of intermediate within stipulated time (1 week of announcement of intermediate result.) Those students who failed to clear complete Intermediate or equivalent degree, their conditional admission will be cancelled.

1.7 The admission calendar for Fall-2025 shall be circulated among applicants through University Website and Official Facebook Page and official WhatsApp channel of the University.

1.8 The change of subject/program within stipulated time period (as mentioned in admission calendar) shall only be allowed, after approval of convener admission committee, to the applicants who have already applied for the desired degree program(s) subject to the availability of vacant seats and eligibility.

Note: % age of fee shall be applicable on all components, except for security and admission charges. Timeline shall be calculated continuously covering both weekdays and weekend.

- 1.9.1 The candidates shall apply for fee refund through Head of Department and Director Students Affair with in time period mentioned above.
- 1.9.2 The Director Students Affairs shall forward the same to the Treasurer Department for further course of action along with following documents.
- 1.9.3 Fee refund form duly signed/stamped by HOD and DSA.
- 1.9.4 Notification of commencement of classes
- 1.9.5 Proof of admission cancellation
- 1.9.6 Original fee paid challan

1.10 Merit List of selected candidates shall be displayed on the University's Notice Boards, Website, WhatsApp channel and Official Facebook Page as per admission calendar.

1.11 Applicant(s) can file the admission grievance(s), if any, along with all required documents in the admission office for redressal within two working days after the display of the merit list(s).

1.12 All selected candidates mentioned in any merit lists shall appear in the Admission Office along with all credentials (in original), CNIC / B-Form, a passport size fresh photograph with blue background and one set of attested copies of all credentials placed in an ordinary paper folder within stipulated time before the notification / display of the next merit list to get bank Challan for the semester fee / dues and securing of admission.

1.13 The admission dues/fee shall be deposited within the stipulated period as specified in the Admission Calendar, at any branch of The Bank of Punjab. A copy of the paid challan must be submitted to the Admission Office for semester registration. Failure to do so will result in non-processing of semester registration.

1.14 In case the semester fee / dues are not deposited within stipulated time the admission offer shall stand cancelled.

1.15 Subject to availability, hostel accommodation shall be provided on the basis of merit, with preference given to candidates holding domicile of districts other than Narowal.

1.16 Equivalence Certificate of "A" Levels or Intermediate Certificate awarded by the foreign institutions issued by the Inter Board Committee of Chairman (IBCC) is mandatory at the time of registration.

1.17 The applicant's upper age limit shall be 24 years for male candidates and 25 years for female candidates as of the admission closing date. No further age relaxation shall be permissible under any circumstances.

1.18 Applicants applying under the University of Narowal Employee Quota must obtain an Employment Certificate from the Registrar Office, University of Narowal. The certificate must Page **3** of **9**





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be submitted at the time of applying for admission.

1.19 In view of the minimum required number of students per section/class and available university resources, the University reserves the right not to offer any degree program(s) without assigning any reason.

1.20 If a degree program is not offered, all deposited semester dues shall be refunded to the applicant, excluding the application processing fee.

1.21 The number of students in each Morning Session section, except for BS Computer Science and BS Education, shall be 60 (comprising 50 Open Merit seats and 10 reserved quota seats). For the Self-Support Session, the quota seat reservation shall not apply, and each section shall consist of 60 Open Merit seats. For the BS Computer Science and BS Education Morning Programs, the total number of seats shall be 50, comprising 40 Open Merit seats and 10 reserved for various quotas. For the BS Computer Science and BS Education Self-Support Programs, the total number of seats shall be 50, all on Open Merit.

1.22 A minimum of 25 students per section is required to commence any program.

1.23 Unless otherwise specified, applicants holding a 3-year relevant Diploma of Associate Engineering (DAE), duly recognized by the **Concerned Board**, may apply against the reserved quota in relevant Morning Programs, and may also apply on open merit in relevant Self-Support Programs, As Specified in **ANNEXURE-I**.

ANNEXURE-II

DETAIL OF RESERVED SEATS IN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS AND ADMISSION CRITERIA

In addition to the above-mentioned general admission criteria, the following conditions shall apply to all applicants applying against reserved seats. These quotas shall be applicable to **Morning Programs only**.

- a. The merit for the reserved seats shall be determined within each respective category, provided that the applicant meets the general minimum admission eligibility criteria.
- b. In case the number of nominations/applicants exceeds the allocated seats for a particular degree program, the University reserves the right to prepare a merit list accordingly within the quota.
- c. Subject to eligibility, a candidate may apply for more than one reserved quota.
- d. The applicant shall be required to submit relevant documentary evidence as proof of eligibility for the claimed reserved quota.

1	Persons with Disability	 a) Two percent (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for special persons in all Undergraduate degree program. b) The applicant shall have to produce a certificate, duly issued by the District Disable Assessment Committee issued by relevant District or federal government.
2.	Sports	 a) Two percent (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for candidates applying under the Sports Quota. b) The applicant shall provide a registration certificate from Country / Provincial / District Sports Board along with certificate(s) of participation at inter college / board / provincelevel issued by the concerned education department / board / province.
3.	Co-CurricularActivities	 a) One percent (1%) seat(s); at least one seat is reserved for candidates applying under the Co-Curricular Activities Quota. b) The applicant shall have to provide certificate(s) in the co-curricular activities at inter college / board / province level issued by the concerned education

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	department / board / province.
 Children, sibling and spouse of UON Employees 	 a) Two percent (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for the children, sibling and spouse of University of Narowal Regular BPS/TTS (excluding staff on deputation) in all Undergraduate Degree Programs. b) The candidates having DAE are not eligible to apply against reserved seat of this quota. However, they may apply against reserve seats of DAE. c) Family Registration Certificate (FRC) and University of Narowal employment certificate issued by Registrar office shall be required along with admission application form.
5. FATA	 a) Two (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for the applicants of FATA in all Undergraduate degree programs. b) The domicile and CNIC of FATA shall be required.
6. Baluchistan	 a) One (1%) seat; at least one seat is reserved for the applicants of Baluchistan in all Undergraduate degree programs. b) The domicile and CNIC of Baluchistan shall be required.
7. Gilgit-Baltistan	 a) One (1%) seat; at least one seat is reserved for the applicants of Gilgit-Baltistan region in all Undergraduate degree programs. b) The domicile and CNIC of Gilgit-Baltistan shall be required.
8. Azad Jammu And Kashmir (AJK)	 a) One (1%) at least one seat for the Azad Jammu andKashmir (AJK) region in all Undergraduate degree programs. b) The domicile and CNIC of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) shall be required.
9. Minorities	 a) Two (2%) at least one seat for Minorities in all Undergraduate degree programs. b) NADRA or Government Body documents for the proof of claim as minority shall be required.

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10. Shuhada	 a) Two (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for thechildren of Shuhada in Army, Police & Rangers. b) Death Certificate (with the reason of Death), letter from the concerned department and Service Book shall be required.
